Call to Order

Mayor Chapman called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

Discussion of Middletown Apartments, Binding Elements #10 & #11

Marilyn Harris, Director of Housing, Metro Louisville was in attendance advocating for the tenants.

She does agree that the road needs to be completed before the CO. She recounted several issues that has slowed the project down - LG&E moving a pipeline and MSD damaging a pipe.

They have 24 potential tenants that have already given notice to their current landlords - out of those there are only 3 that may be affected.

Mayor Chapman inquired as to why HPI was not in attendance. Ms. Harris advised that they were not invited.

The commissioners and mayor were in consensus that a temporary CO not be approved because the road work has not been completed per binding elements #10 and #11.
