MEETING MINUTES

Present at the meeting representing Bell Engineering: Josh Karrick, Tyler Dixon and Joe Marwil

Mayor Chapman advised that we had received federal grants for Wetherby and Bliss sidewalks that is an 80/20 match.

Joe Marwil gave a synopsis of the project design. They will tie into existing driveways and will not dig in the driveways. There may be one tree that will need to come down. They will check the new Metro Tree Ordinance.

They will take 7' of ROW - this will be the public ROW.

The audience asked if MSD was contacted regarding the drainage project - they will contact them.

Residents at 204 Bliss voiced support of the project.

Plans will go to Frankfort, KYTC and MSD for approval.

219 and 224 Bliss have limited parking - Mr. Marwil advised there will be minimal loss.

Someone asked why we are putting sidewalks on Bliss - we are trying to connect to Shelbyville Road.

11813 Wetherby stated that they felt the busiest road was not getting the sidewalk.

They will re-sod and re-seed when they are finished.

Why curbs and gutters - KYTC wants them for safety and water run-off.

Resident on the corner of Wetherby and Bliss is concerned about her fence.

Most of the crowd would like the walk all the way down Wetherby

Bell Engineering will meet with the owners who were in attendance that had concerns this may take 3-4 weeks.
