Amending Ordinance No. 14-13, Series 2014

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE AMENDMENT OF THE
ADDITIONAL DRAINAGE DETENTION REQUIREMENT FOR ANY DEVELOPMENT
PLAN APPROVAL IN THE CITY OF MIDDLETOWN

WHEREAS, the City of Middletown Commission finds that there have been significant drainage problems within the City and that it would promote the public health and safety to establish an additional drainage detention requirement for any development plan approval requested from the City of Middletown,

AND WHEREAS, the City Commission additionally finds that the additional drainage detention requirement for all development plan approvals would not serve to unduly burden property owners requesting such approvals and that the benefits for both the requesting property owners and the surrounding properties far outweighs any cost of compliance,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIDDLETOWN, KENTUCKY:


SECTION 1:


As part of the City of Middletown Commission's approval process for any Development Plan (or a major revision thereto); the following standard shall apply, but only if MSD has determined that the Development Plan must show on-site detention:

- (a) In areas of the City of Middletown south of Shelbyville Road, Post-development peak flows will be 50% less than pre-developed peak flows from development for 100-year storms.

SECTION 2:

This ordinance shall take effect upon enactment and publication according to law.
