AT&T Discussion

Mayor Chapman started the discussion by saying we stopped AT&T fiber installation in Beckley Woods - now what do we do. We need to get this done and behind us.

Gary Edelen, President of Beckley Woods HOA advised the residents will not be happy if the city gets out of it and they must deal with AT&T individually.
