Municipal Order 04-08-21-C Accepting change order for in car cameras for MPD

Attorney Singler advised this is a change order to the existing contract to add in car cameras. Chief Herman said this will add another layer of protection for the city.

Municipal Order 04-08-21-F Accepting a Change Order for Paving

Mayor Chapman said this is to resurface the First Baptist Church parking lot as per the agreement. Attorney Singler read the municipal order advising this is a change order to the current paving contract.

Commissioner Hayden made a motion to approve Municipal Order 04-08-21-F and Commissioner Wolf seconded the motion. Motion carries.

Ordinance 04-08-21-A Enacting & Adopting a Supplement to the Code of Ordinances, first reading

Attorney Singler stated this is the annual update to the code of ordinances and this is the first reading.

Commission Oliver made a motion to consider this the first reading of Ordinance 04-08-21-A and Commissioner Hayden seconded the motion. Motion carries.

Discussion: Regulating Smoking Retail Stores

Attorney Singler advised this is an amendment to the Land Development Code that will regulate smoke stores.

The commission wanted to explore this option and Attorney Singler will come up with something for the May meeting.
