Municipal Order 05-26-21-A Relating to Noise

Mayor Chapman stated we have been getting complaints about noise emanating from Blind Squirrel. We have a noise ordinance but this one is more detailed and one we could go to court with.

Attorney Singler read the municipal order. It was decided to table this until we get some readings from Blind Squirrel.
