ORDINANCE 3-16-22-A, SERIES 2022
AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF ELECTED
OFFICIALS OF THE CITY OF MIDDLETOWN

WHEREAS, the City Council is aware City's Ordinance Section 31.02 states that the City Commission shall establish the compensation of every elected city officer and Kentucky Revised Statutes 83A.75 requires that compensation for elected representatives be set by ordinance,

AND WHEREAS, the City Council is aware that KRS 83A.070 requires that the pay of elected representatives must be set prior to the first Monday in May in the year that the officer is elected,

AND WHEREAS, the City council has reviewed the records of the City relating to pay for elected officials and finds that the compensation of the City Mayor and City Commissioners should be raised to an amount more appropriate to the size of the City of Middletown and the responsibilities of the office,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION:

- Section 1. The compensation of the Mayor is hereby fixed at the sum of \$2,000.00 per month, or \$24,000.00 per year, commencing with the beginning of the Mayor's new term, January 2023.
- Section 2. The compensation of the Commissioners is hereby fixed at the sum of \$1,000.00 per month, or \$12,000.00 per year, commencing with the beginning of the Commission's new term, January 2023.
- Section 3. Any ordinance, or section of an ordinance, in conflict with the foregoing sections is hereby repealed and replaced.


