

**CITY OF MIDDLETOWN
ORDINANCE 05-12-22-A
AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SCHEDULE I OF CHAPTER 74, TRAFFIC
SCHEDULES**

WHEREAS, the Commission of the City of Middletown wishes to update their ordinances and keep them current; and

WHEREAS, there is a regulation that prohibits Truck traffic on several roads in the city, and this is out of date and no longer relevant and the city wishes to repeal the restriction;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City of Middletown that Schedule I of Chapter 74, Traffic Schedules, of the City of Middletown Codified Ordinances, be and hereby is repealed in its entirety:

SECTION 1: Amendment to 92.02, Property Maintenance Standards

CHAPTER 74: TRAFFIC SCHEDULES

Schedule

I. Truck traffic

~~SCHEDULE I. TRUCK TRAFFIC.~~

~~—(A) As used herein, TRUCK or MOTOR TRUCK shall mean any motor-propelled vehicle designed for carrying freight or merchandise with a load capacity of over 1,000 pounds, and shall also include any motor-propelled vehicle designed to draw and support the front end of a semi-trailer.~~

~~—(B) It shall be unlawful for any person to operate, or cause to be operated, any motor truck on Wetherby Avenue from Evergreen Road to North Madison within the city.~~

~~—(C) The provisions of this schedule shall not apply to a motor truck making pick-ups or deliveries to or from any building or structure located on or adjacent to the street whereon trucks are prohibited, or for the purpose of delivering materials to be used in the repair, alteration, remodeling or construction of any building or structure for which a building permit has been obtained.~~

~~—(D) Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than \$25 and not more than \$500. Each entry upon a street on which trucks are prohibited shall be deemed a separate offense.~~

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval by the Commissioners of the City of Middletown, Kentucky and by publication or distribution as required by law.


